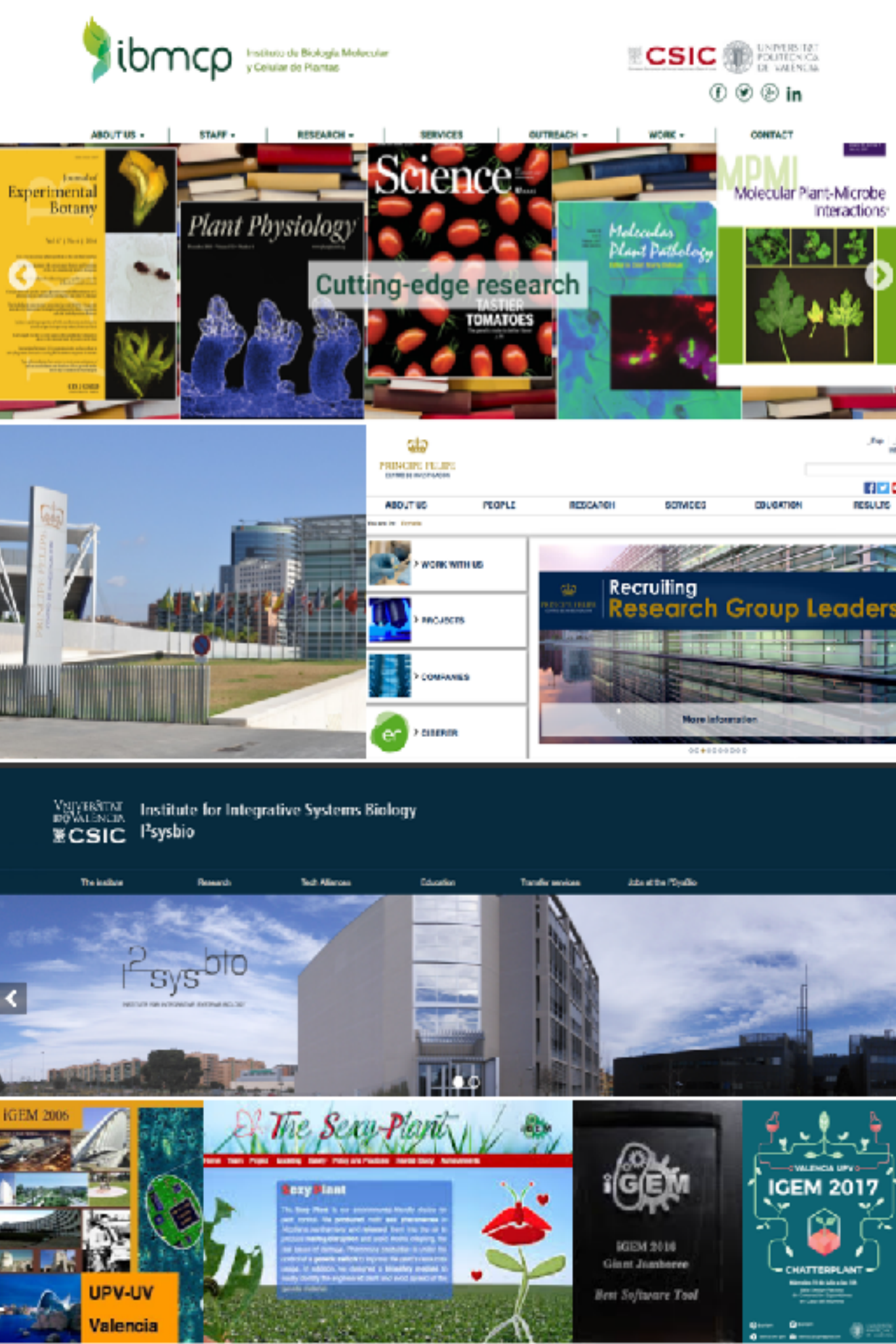

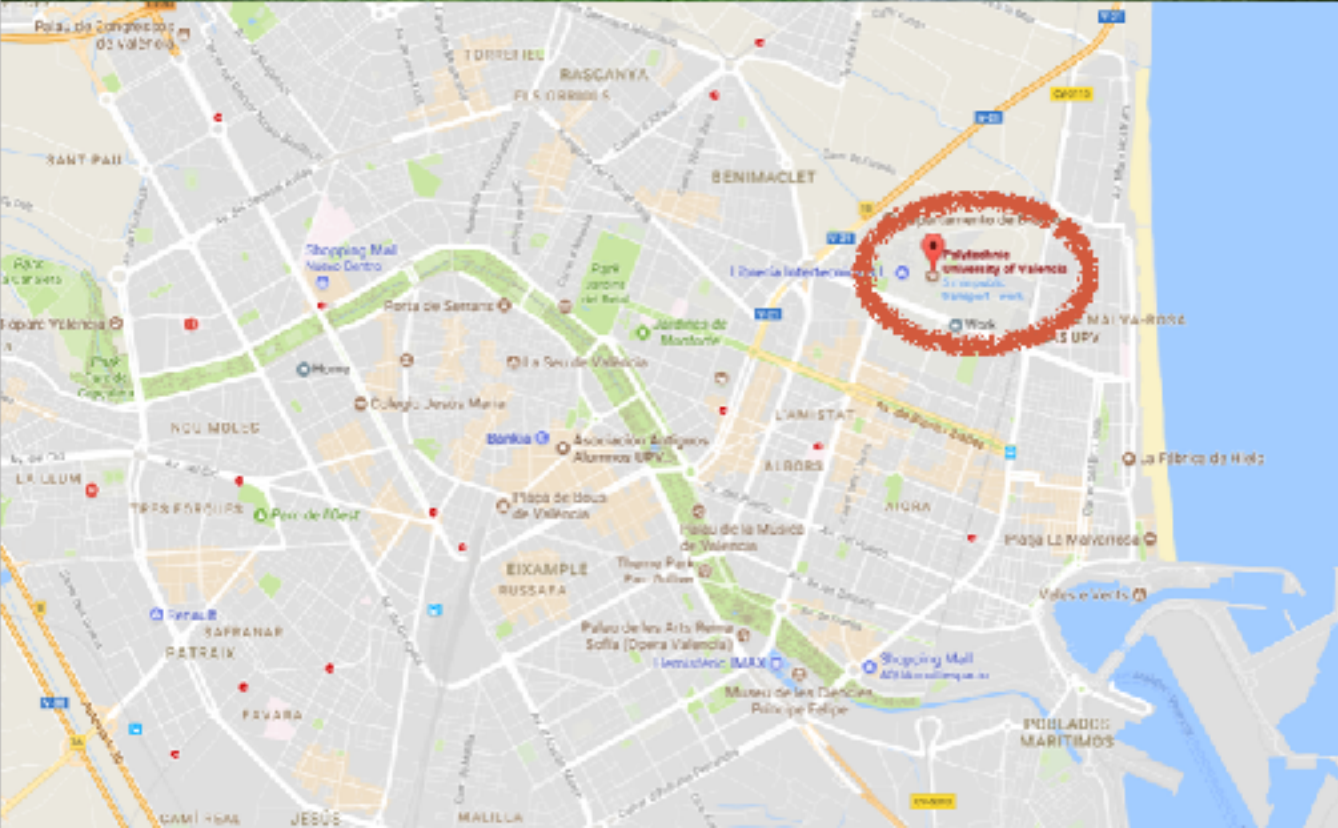

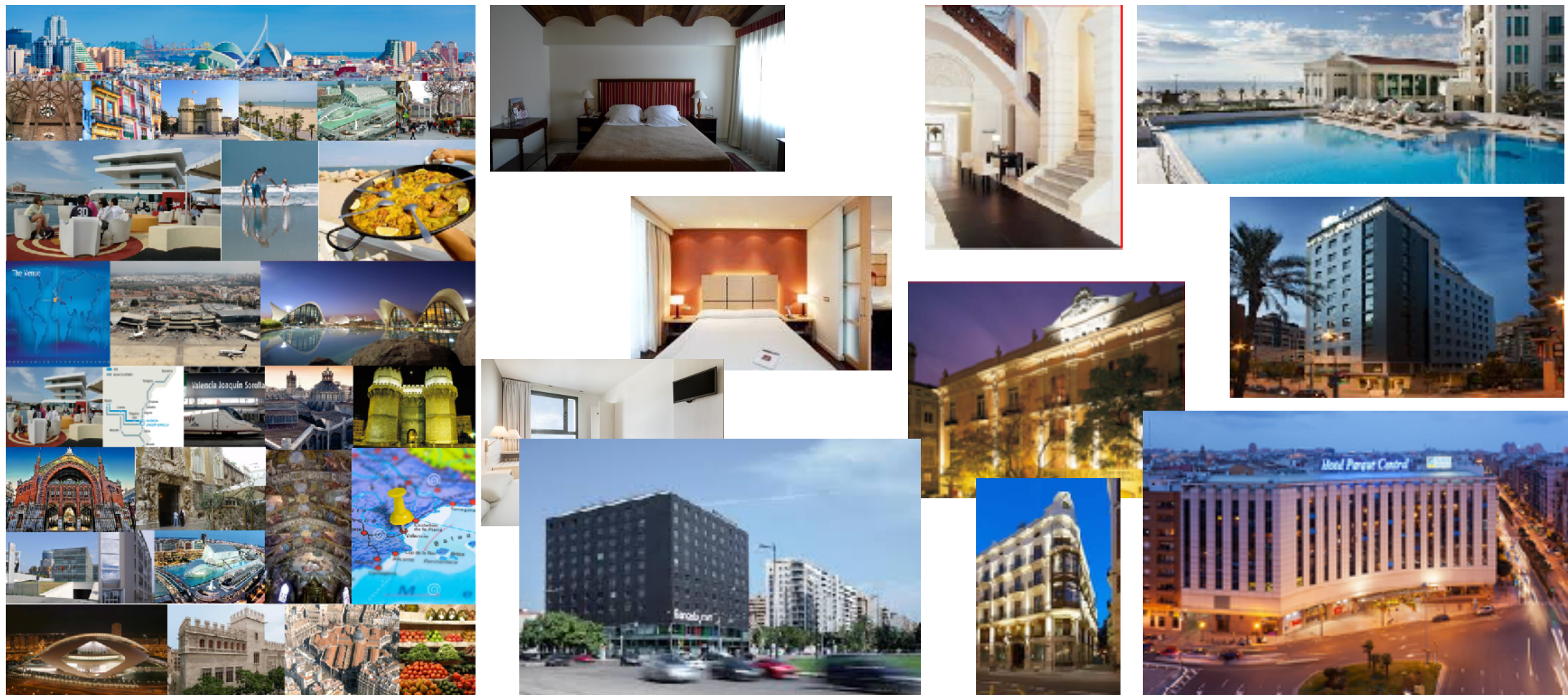


# VENUE

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- Universitat Politècnica de València (UPV), ([www.upv.es/index-en.html](http://www.upv.es/index-en.html)): Spain's top technological university according to the major global rankings assessing higher education quality.
- Over 42,000 members: about 37,800 students, 2,600 lecturers and 1,700 management and service personnel.
- 15 schools and faculties
- UPV's Vera Campus:
